

## For Tablets and Phones

On a desktop or laptop computer, Hoopla is accessed through your web browser. You can also use it on a phone or tablet.

The Hoopla app is available



through your device's app store. It is free to download and install.

Once you have done so, you can log in or create an account.

Unlike a computer, the Hoopla app allows you to download items and use them on the go, even when you don't have an internet connection. After borrowing, just tap the 'Download' button and wait for it to finish loading.

## What is Hoopla?

Hoopla is a digital download service that the library offers to card holders. It has a variety of content, including music, movies, audiobooks, and comics. There are over three hundred thousand things to choose from! New items are added weekly, including many recently released albums and books.

Hoopla content is always available. You can check out up to 20 items a month.

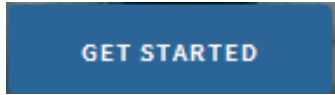

## Getting Started With Hoopla

In order to use Hoopla, you must first create an account. There is a “get started” button in the center of the page.



Click this to begin.

**You will need to enter a working email address and a password that you can remember.**

Select TCPL as your library. It may also ask for your library card number, which is found under the barcode, and your PIN, which is usually the last four digits of your phone number.

Once you have registered, you will only need your e-mail and password to log in!



## Your Hoopla Account

When you log in, you see your “Currently Borrowed” page. This shows things you already have checked out. You can also reach this through the “My Hoopla” link.

You are allowed twenty (20) checkouts per month.



Your remaining checkouts shows up at the upper-left under the Hoopla logo, as well as at the bottom of your account home page.

At the upper-right corner is the “Settings” link. This page lets you change your email address, password, and other account details such as kid-friendly mode.

You can save items as favorites to make them easy to find again. Just tap the heart icon when viewing an item.

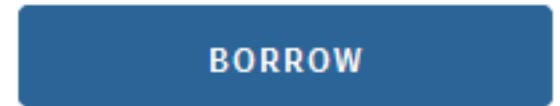
## Searching and Browsing

You can browse the Hoopla categories, or do a search for a title, author, or subject. Each category is broken down into genres, as well as new and popular materials. The “filter” button lets you sort items and set audience or release date. Tap a cover to get more details.

## Checking Out

Checkout is simple! Just hit the ‘borrow’ button and it is added to your home page.

Below the borrow button is



information of checkout length and whether it can be downloaded to a device.

Once you have borrowed it, you may press the Play button to start using item. Hoopla tracks your place and will resume from the same spot if you don't finish.
